I further acknowledge that making a false, fictitious, or fraudulent statement or representation in this sworn affidavit is punishable under the criminal laws of Colorado as perjury in the second degree under Colorado Revised Statute 18-8-503 and it shall constitute a separate criminal offense each time a public benefit is fraudulently received.

## **PROOF OF IDENTIFICATION**

In addition to the signed affidavit of citizenship/legal residency, a copy of one of the following types of identification must be provided:

- \_\_\_ Valid Colorado driver license or identification card bearing Applicant's photograph
- \_\_\_ Valid driver's license or identification card bearing applicant's photograph issued by a lawful presence state. All states are lawful presence states including the District of Columbia with the exception of:
  - Hawaii, Illinois, Maryland, Nebraska, New Mexico, Utah, and Washington
- \_\_\_ U.S. military card or military dependent's identification card
- \_\_\_ U.S. Coast Guard Merchant Mariner Card
- \_\_\_ Native American Tribal Document
- \_\_\_ U.S. naturalization certificate bearing Applicant's intact photograph impressed with the raised embossed seal of the issuing agency
- \_\_\_ U.S. certificate of citizenship with bearing Applicant's intact photograph impressed with the raised embossed seal of the issuing agency
- \_\_\_ Valid immigration documents demonstrating lawful presence and verified through the Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements, administered by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security.

If you are unable to provide one of the verifiable forms of identification, a waiver may be requested through the Colorado Department of Revenue.
