COLORADO RENT-TO-OWN NOTIFICATION RENEWAL INFORMATION

IMPORTANT INFORMATION – The renewal is now available online!

Your online renewal and fee are due by January 31, 2021. You must have a login to the community licensing portal to access the renewal. Once your renewal is submitted, we will send it to the people listed on the renewal as signatories. The renewal will not be considered complete until we receive signatures back from the signatories.

You may select your method of fee during the renewal, but must pay the fee by the following methods:

The Rent-to-Own renewal fee is **\$25**.

- **Pay electronically using a checking account or credit card** – Please note there is a fee associated with making a payment online. To pay online, visit the Licensing webpage at: coag.gov/uccc/renew.
- **Mail a check to our office** – You may send a check payment for your renewal. Checks should be made payable to the “Colorado Uniform Consumer Credit Code” or “Colorado UCCC.”

Your renewal and fee are due January 31st. If you do not submit your notification form and fee by the date, you may not make rent-to-own transactions or collect rent-to-own payments.

Colorado regulates the rent-to-own industry under the Colorado Rental Purchase Agreement Act. Rent-to-Own companies must file initial notification and pay the initial \$50.00 fee for each rent-to-own location within 30 days after first entering into rental purchase agreements. Then, filing notification and paying the \$25.00 fee annually for each rent-to-own location is required pursuant to §§ 5-10-804 and 5-10-805, C.R.S.

You are required to file the online Rent-to-Own Renewal Notification and pay the renewal notification fee for each rent-to-own location.
