



## Colorado Opioid Abatement Council Committee Descriptions

### *Administrative Committee*

The Administrative Committee will provide administrative support to the Colorado Opioid Abatement Council (COAC), and where appropriate, to Regional Opioid Abatement Councils and Participating Local Governments. The Committee may collaborate with the Department of Law's Opioid Response Unit to provide such administrative support to the COAC, the Regional Councils, and/or Participating Local Governments.

The Committee's initial priorities include developing expectation and conflict of interest policies for the COAC, as well as procedures for Regional Councils to challenge remedial actions taken by the COAC. The Committee will also develop policies related to the COAC's interactions and communications with Regional Councils.

### *Regional Abatement Assistance Committee*

The Regional Abatement Assistance Committee is available to support Regional Opioid Abatement Councils and local governments seeking guidance related to the expenditure of their Opioid Settlement Funds and development of the regions' 2-year plans. The Committee may collaborate with the Department of Law's Opioid Response Unit to provide such support and guidance to Regional Councils and local governments.

The Committee's initial priorities will be the development of toolkits and other materials to support the development of Regional Councils' 2-year plans.

### *2-Year Plan Review Committee*

The 2-Year Plan **Review** Committee will conduct the final review of Regional Councils' 2-Year Plans to determine whether they comply with the MOU. When appropriate, the Committee may provide feedback and suggestions to Regional Councils to support the finalization of 2-Year Plans. The Committee may collaborate with the Department of Law's Opioid Response Unit to provide such feedback and suggestions to Regional Councils. The Committee will develop 2-Year Plan summaries and recommendations to the COAC for the COAC's ultimate approval of a Region's 2-Year Plan.

The Committee's initial priorities will be the creation of procedures for the submission and review of Regions' 2-Year Plans.
