CHARGES:

COUNT ONE: Attempt to Influence a Public Servant, C.R.S § 18-8-306,
(F4) [24051]

COUNT TWO: Perjury C.R.S. §§ 1-13-104 and 18-8-503, C.R.S (M2) [25022]

Philip J. Weiser, Attorney General for the State of Colorado, in the name and by the authority of the People of the State of Colorado, pursuant to § 1-13-101, C.R.S. and Crim. P. 8(a)(2), informs the court of the following offenses committed, or triable, in the City and County of Denver, State of Colorado:

COUNT ONE
ATTEMPT TO INFLUENCE A PUBLIC SERANT
C.R.S. § 18-8-306 (F4)

On or about March 6, 2022 through June 15, 2022, DIANA ELLEN WATT, unlawfully and feloniously attempted to influence Secretary of State Jena Griswold and her employees, agents and/or designees within the Colorado Secretary of State's Office are the listed public servants, by means of deceit, with the intent thereby to alter or affect the public servant's decision, vote, opinion, or action concerning a matter which was to be considered or performed by the public servant or the agency or body of which the public servant was a member; in violation of section 18-8-306, C.R.S.

COUNT TWO
PERJURY
C.R.S. §§ 1-13-104, C.R.S. and 18-8-503 (M2)

On or about March 6, 2022, DIANA ELLEN WATT, unlawfully, having taken an oath or made an affirmation required by the Uniform Election Code of 1992 (Articles 1 to 13, Title 1 of the Colorado Revised Statutes), did swear or affirm willfully, corruptly, and falsely in a manner material to the issue or point in question or suborn any other person to swear or affirm as aforesaid; and/or with an intent to mislead a public servant, namely: Secretary of State Jena Griswold and her employees, agents and/or designees within the Colorado Secretary of State's Office, in the performance of the public servant's duty, unlawfully made a materially false statement, regarding an Affidavit of Circulator, which she did not believe to be true, under an oath required or authorized by law; in violation of sections 1-13-104, and 18-8-503, C.R.S.

All offenses against the peace and dignity of the People of the State of Colorado.
