



Duplicate reports

Duplicate reports are those regarding a concern or event that has already been reported, and they indicate a healthy culture of reporting safety concerns in a community. 1,997 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year; 394 duplicates were reported in October alone—a 73% decrease compared to September.

96.1% Valid reports



96.1% of reports received during the 2024-2025 school year, which began August 1, 2024, were determined to be valid. Valid reports are those requiring a response, and that are made with the intent to protect, prevent harm, or help.

Sample reports

Correct use of Safe2Tell

A person reported a student was self-harming and that they saw marks on the student's body. School teams investigated and met with the student and parent. The student is attending weekly counseling sessions.

Correct use of Safe2Tell

A person reported a student was verbally inappropriate and sexually assaulting peers in their class. School teams investigated the situation and had a restorative conversation with the student, notified their parents, and took school disciplinary action.
