Proposed Draft Amendments to Colorado Privacy Act Rules

**VERSION 3 OF PROPOSED DRAFT AMENDMENTS TO THE CPA RULES  
December 5, 2024**

This document contains final revisions to the proposed draft amendments to the Colorado Privacy Act (CPA) rules that were published by the Secretary of State on September 25, 2024 and to version 2 of the proposed draft amendments, filed on October 30, 2024.

This version 3 of the proposed draft amendments constitutes the rules as adopted by the Colorado Department of Law (the “Department”). The Department has requested an Attorney General opinion letter for this version 3, as required by C.R.S. 24-4-103(11)(d). Once the opinion letter is received, the adopted rules will be filed with the Secretary of State for publication in the Colorado Register. The amended rules will become effective 20 days after publication in the Register.

### **I. Public Input Considered in These Revisions**

After publishing the proposed draft amendments to the CPA Rules on September 25, 2024, the Department welcomed feedback through a written comment portal.

On October 30, 2024, the Department published version 2 of the proposed draft amendments, which included revisions seeking to address concerns expressed through public input received between September 25, 2024 and October 23, 2024. On November 7, 2024, the Department received comments on the proposed draft amendments at a public hearing. Additionally, the public written comment portal for these rules remained open through the end of the day on November 7, 2024. This third version of the proposed draft amendments contains revisions seeking to address oral and written stakeholder comments received through November 7, 2024.

### **III. Proposed Draft Rule Revisions**
