## MEMORANDUM

- RE: Rocky Mountain Arsenal Project Proposals, Supplemental Memo

## BACKGROUND

The previously distributed memo and calculations concerning the four projects staff recommends the Trustee approve as Rocky Mountain Arsenal Projects linked to an outdated draft project proposal, rendering incorrect the dollar amounts previously quoted.

## UPDATE

This memo contains updated and corrected dollar amounts for the recommended allocation - described as Scenario 4 in the original memorandum. It replaces the draft Bluff Lake proposal previously circulated, which requested \$500,000, with the correct and final proposal, which requests \$600,000.

## **RECOMMENDED ACTIONS**

Staff recommends the Trustees approve funding of all four projects pursuant to updated funding Scenario 4, detailed in the chart below. Further, staff recommends the \$791.97 remaining be allocated to Bluff Lake for a total \$564,791.97.

As stated in the original memo, staff requests the Trustees authorize staff to determine how to allocate the funds from between the two RMA NRD accounts. Staff also requests the Trustees grant staff discretion to allocate any remaining funds, including interest that accrues after the date of the projects' approval, to one or more of these four projects, closer to the completion of the projects.
