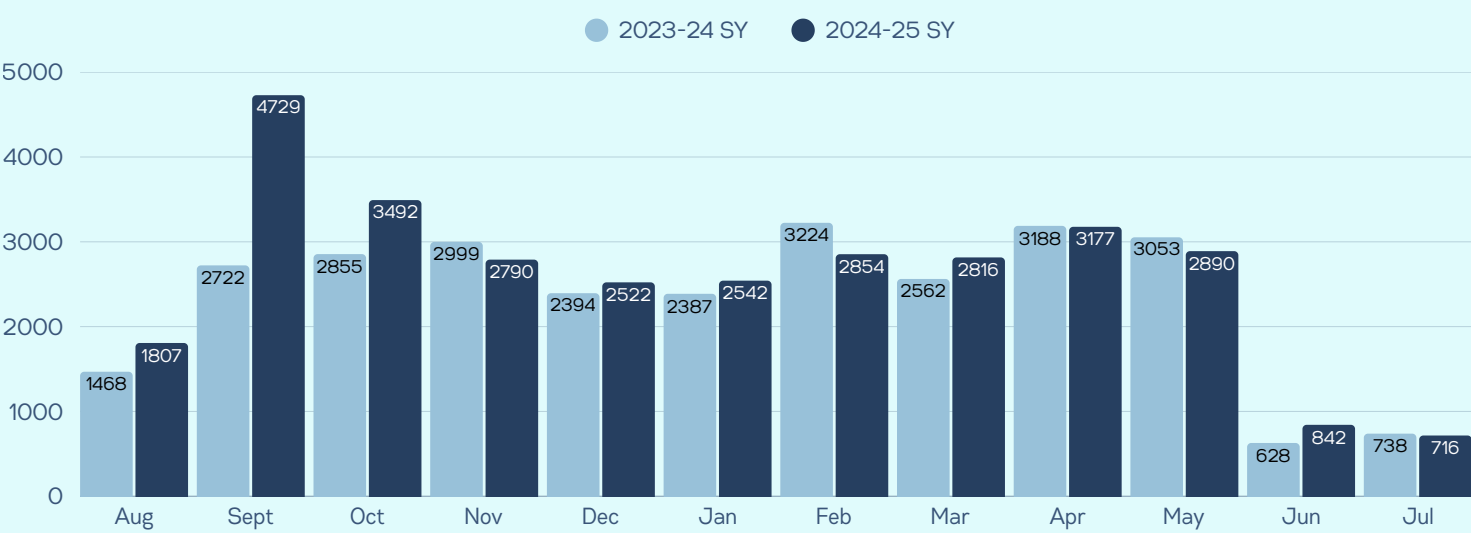

and 31,177 reports were received to date for the current school year.

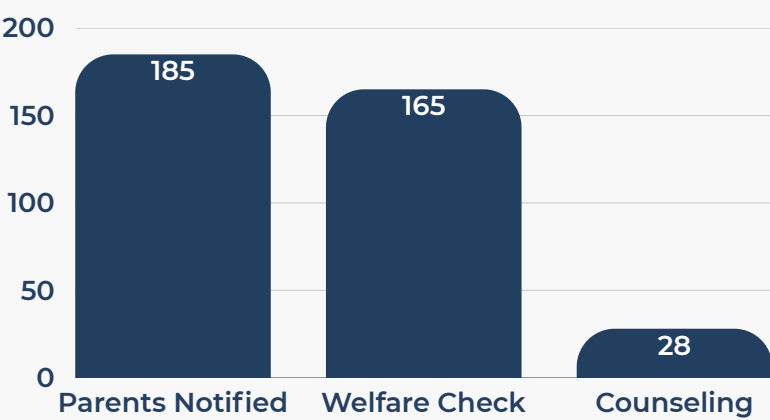

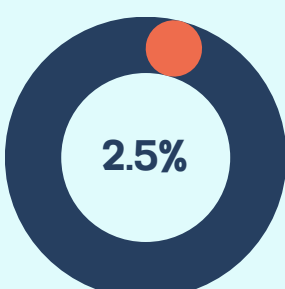

Report Example

A student reported a desire to harm themselves, and they were drinking, taking drugs, and abused at home. Local law enforcement spoke with the student's parents, conducted a welfare check, and transferred the student to the hospital on a hold.

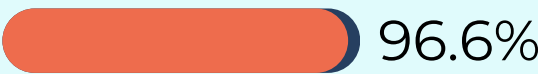


Duplicate Reports this SY



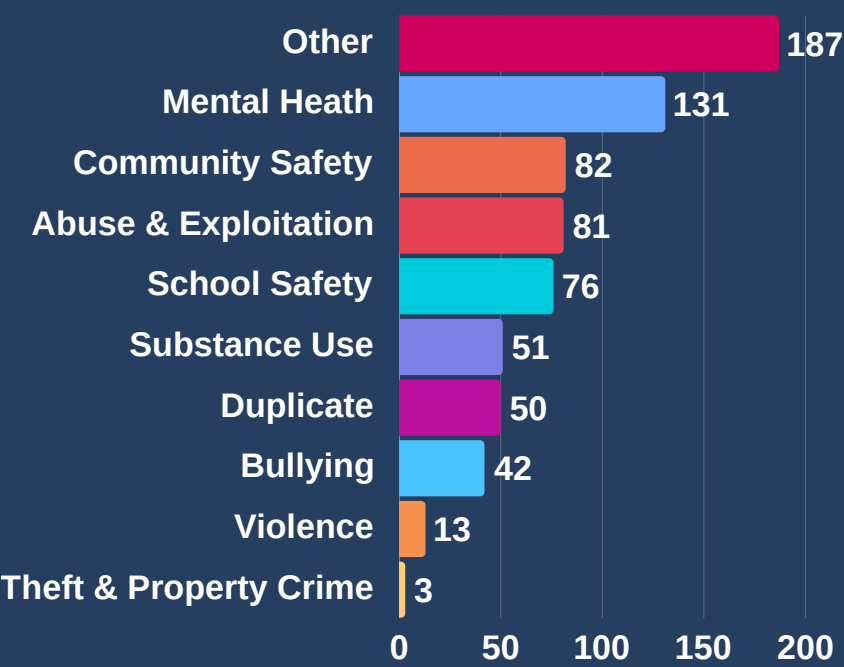
3,923 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year.

Valid reports during this SY



96.6% of reports received during the 24-25 school year, which began 8/1/24, were determined to be valid. Misuse reports were 1.2%, and false reports were 2.2%

July Reporting Themes



Report Example

A student shared with a peer that their parent was physically abusing them. The student has bruises and expressed not wanting to live at home. Local law enforcement conducted a welfare check, but no one answered the door. Department of Human Service has been involved.
