
3,340 reports were received in October 2025,
and 8,975 reports were received to date for the current school year.




OCTOBER REPORT TYPES

Report Example

A report was made about a student who was vaping, missing class, and possibly self-harming. School staff investigated, spoke with the student and their parent, and connected the student with the school counselor. The student is also receiving outside support.




Duplicate Reports this SY




1,671 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year.

Valid reports during this SY



97.7% of reports received during the 25-26 school year, which began 8/1/25, were determined to be valid. Misuse reports were 0.9%, and false reports were 1.4%

October Reporting Themes



Report Example

A report was made about a student potentially using alcohol and other substances in and outside of school. School staff investigated, searched the student's backpack, and found an empty flask. The student admitted to past substance use but stated they no longer engage in it. Parents were contacted and confirmed the student is in therapy. The student was offered additional addiction support through school counseling, and staff will continue to monitor them.
