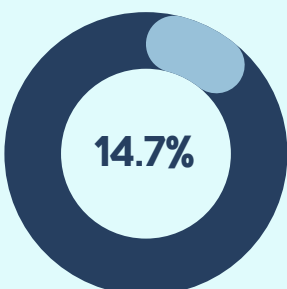
2,216 reports were received in December 2025, and 14,229 reports were received to date for the current school year.



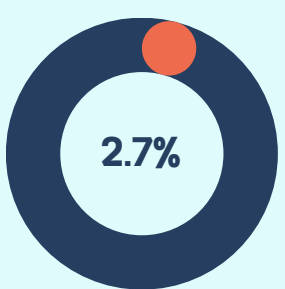
DECEMBER REPORT TYPES



self reports



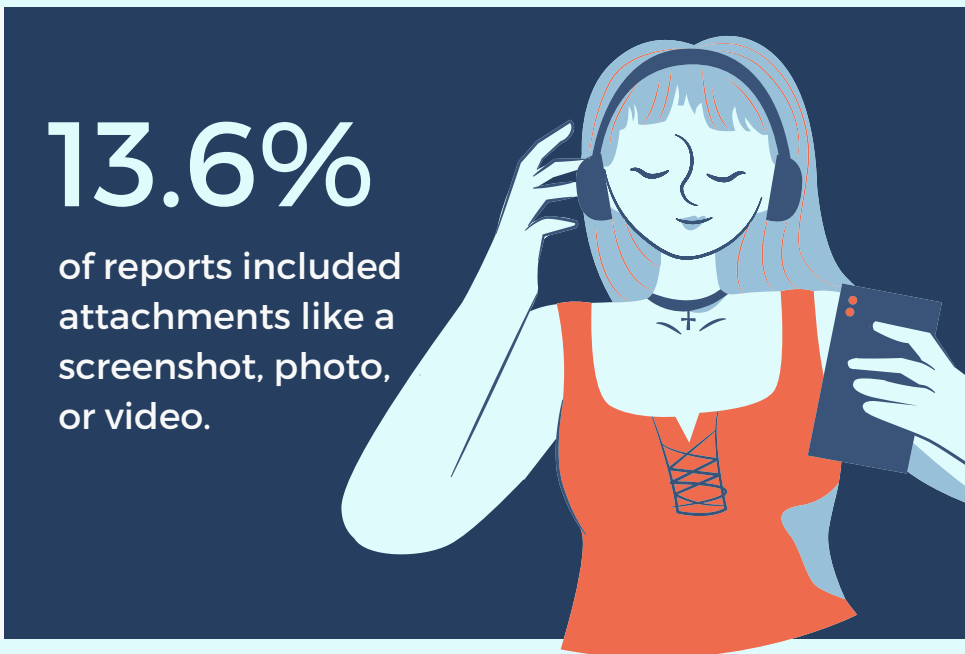

Report Example

A student reportedly made repeated comments about shooting teachers, peers, and themselves. Law enforcement conducted a welfare check and informed the student's parents. The student stated the remarks were intended as a joke and denied suicidal or homicidal thoughts. The student will remain out of school until a threat assessment is completed.

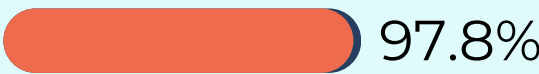


Duplicate Reports this SY



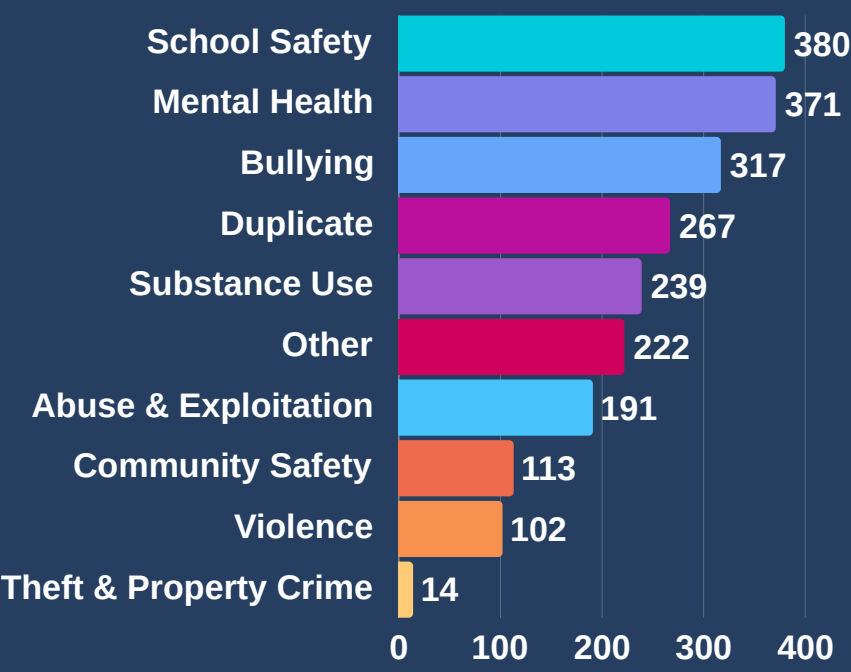
2,522 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year.

Valid reports during this SY



97.8% of reports received during the 25-26 school year, which began 8/1/25, were determined to be valid. Misuse reports were 0.7%, and false reports were 1.5%

December Reporting Themes



Report Example

A concern was reported about a student self-harming at school. The school resource officer conducted a welfare check and contacted the parent, who arranged emergency care. The school completed a suicide risk assessment, and the student will receive ongoing mental health support from the school counselor.
