3,008 reports were received in February 2026, and 19,792 reports were received to date for the current school year.

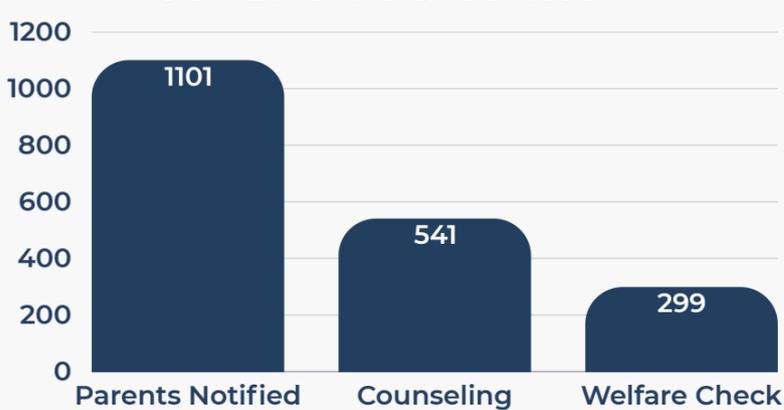

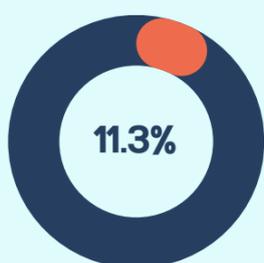

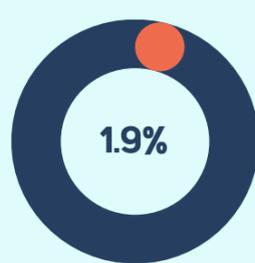

Duplicate Reports this SY



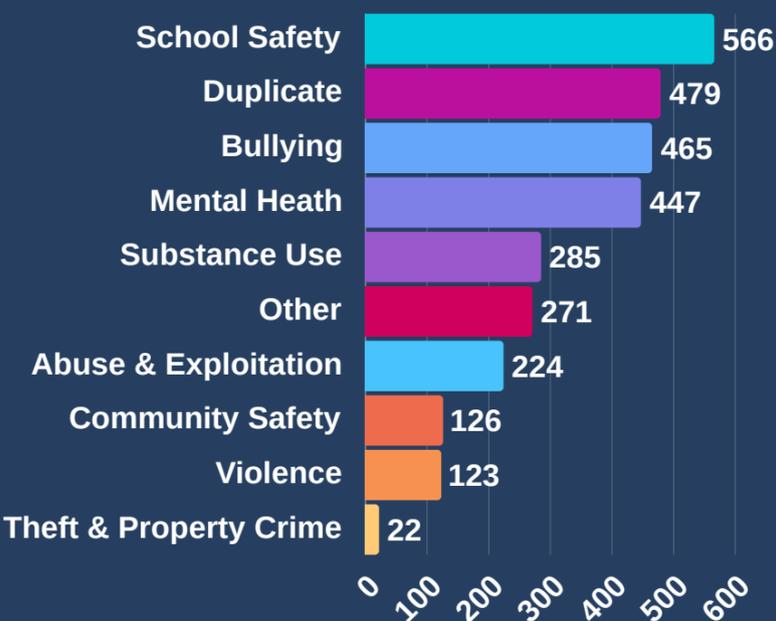
3,372 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year.

97.7% of reports received during the 25-26 school year, which began 8/1/25, were determined to be valid. Misuse reports were 0.7%, and false reports were 1.6%

Report Example

A report indicated that a student was experiencing abuse at home and was kicked out. A welfare check was conducted, school staff spoke with the student, Colorado Department of Human Services was notified, and the student was connected with counseling support.
