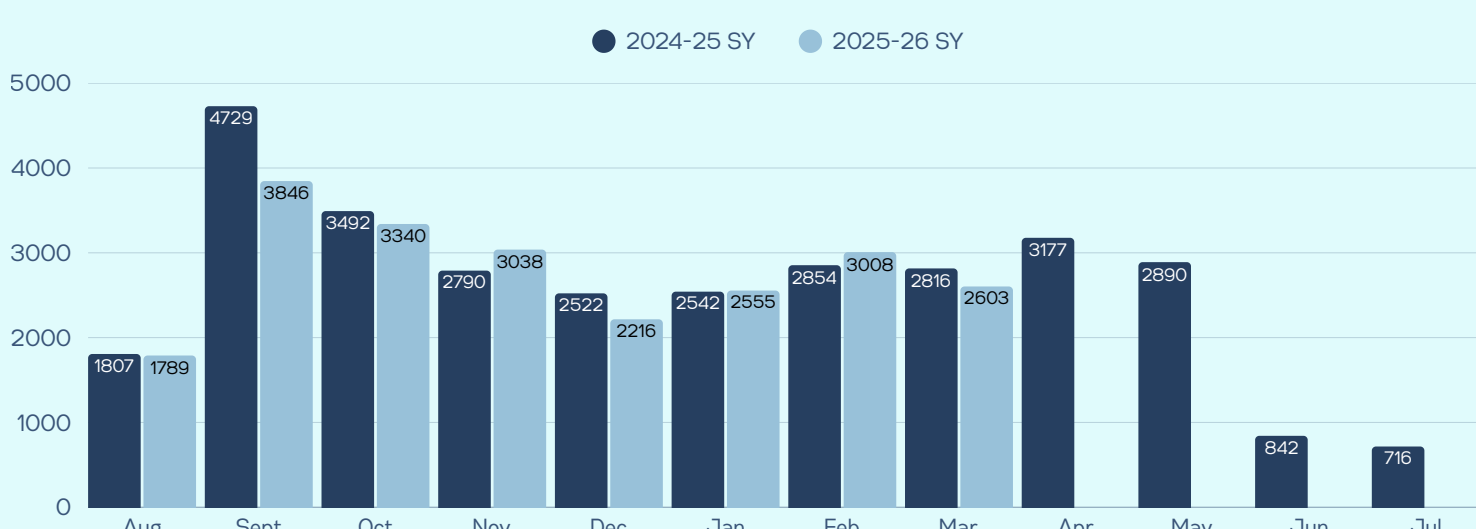




# MARCH 2026 MONTHLY REPORT

2,603 reports were received in March 2026, and 22,359 reports were received to date for the current school year.

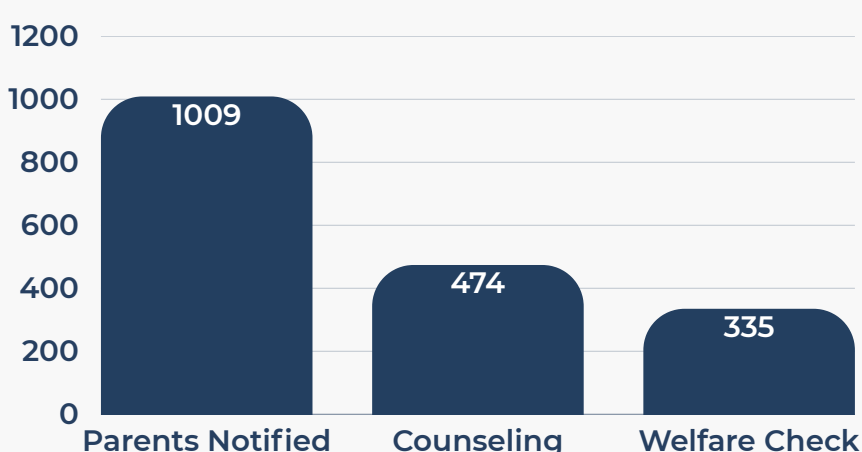

Suicide - 251

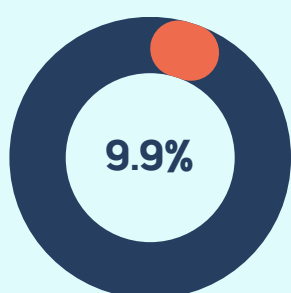

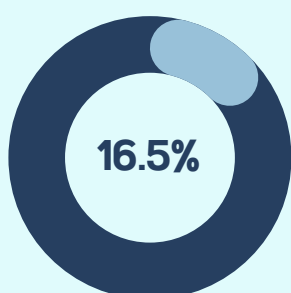

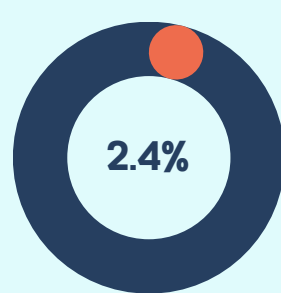

### Report Example

A person reported that a student attempted to end their life. Law enforcement completed a welfare check and spoke with the student and their parent. The parent transported the student to the hospital, where the student was placed on an emergency mental health hold. The school conducted a suicide risk assessment and is providing support.

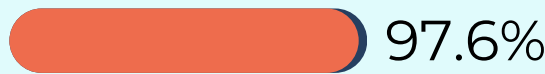


### Duplicate Reports this SY



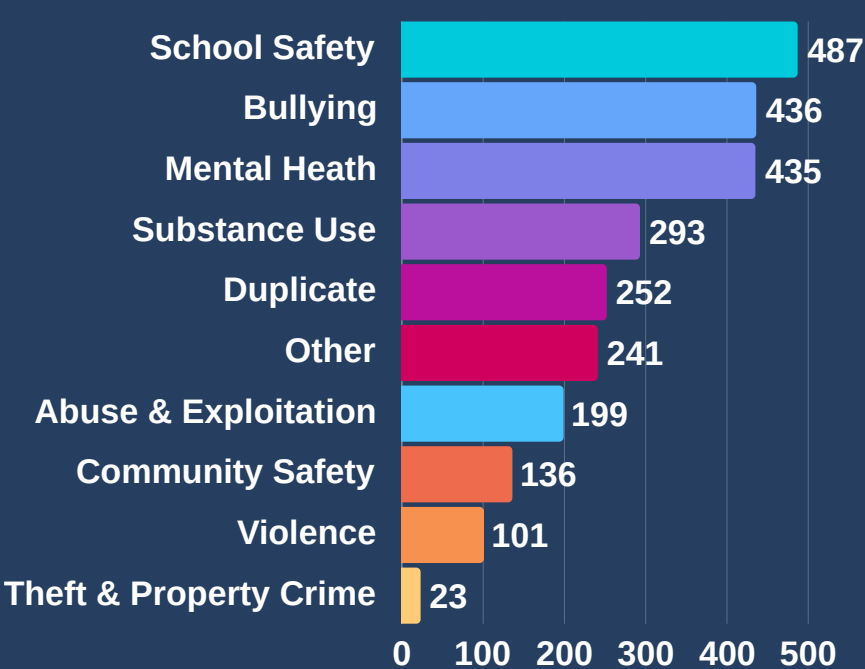
3,629 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year.

### Valid reports during this SY



97.6% of reports received during the 25-26 school year, which began 8/1/25, were determined to be valid. Misuse reports were 0.7%, and false reports were 1.7%

A person reported that a student in class was yelling, screaming at others, and hitting themselves with their Chromebook. School teams spoke with the student and their parents, held a restorative conversation, took school disciplinary action, and confirmed the student is receiving counseling services.
