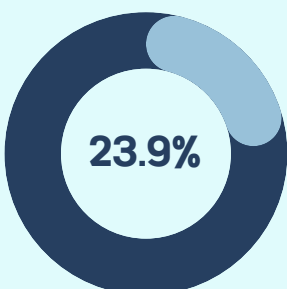
672 reports were received in June 2026,
and 28,711 reports were received to date for the current school year.



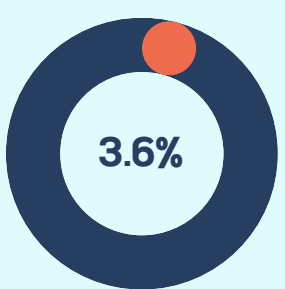
JUNE REPORT TYPES

Report Example

A person reported that a student physically and verbally assaulted another student and then made a threat against the student’s life. School staff investigated, spoke with individuals at the scene, contacted the student’s parents, and implemented school disciplinary action.

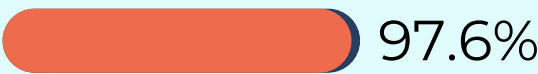

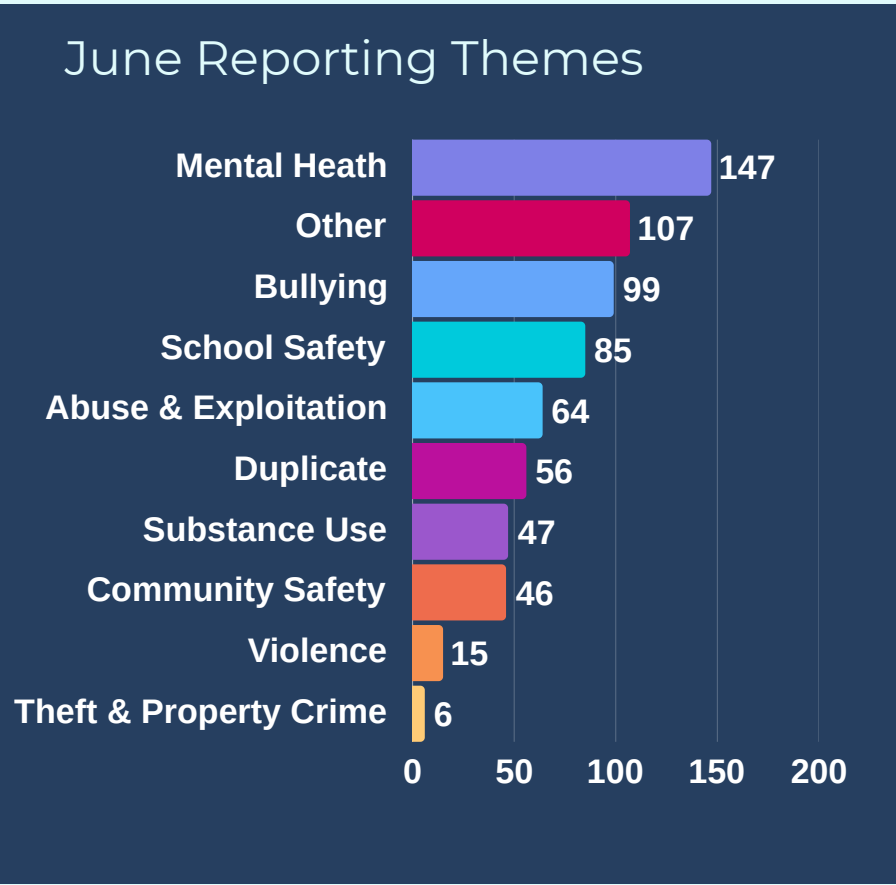


4,235 duplicate reports have been reported during the current school year.

97.6% of reports received during the 25-26 school year, which began 8/1/25, were determined to be valid. Misuse reports were 0.6%, and false reports were 1.8%



Report Example

A person reported that a student expressed having suicidal ideation, that they were self-harming, and told peers they felt unwanted. Local law enforcement conducted a welfare check and spoke with the student who admitted having suicidal thoughts. The student’s parents were notified, the student was placed on an M-1 hold, and they are now receiving counseling services.
