**CLINTON DEE FRALEY RECEIVES MAXIMUM SENTENCE OF 12 YEARS FOR
SECURITIES FRAUD**

DENVER — The [Colorado Attorney General's Office](#) announced today that Clinton Dee Fraley (D.O.B. 01/05/77) of Englewood received the maximum sentence of 12 years by an Arapahoe County judge for stealing more than \$532,000 from four Colorado investors. Fraley was [charged in July](#) after an extensive and thorough investigation by the [Colorado Division of Securities](#). He pled guilty to the securities fraud charge. Restitution is still being litigated.

“This is a successful outcome for this white-collar criminal who preyed upon investors to afford his lavish lifestyle. We are still working to secure restitution for his victims,” said Attorney General John Suthers.
