Office of the Attorney General to Hold Public Hearing on Rocky Mountain Health Plan Conversion in Grand Junction

On September 8, 2016, Rocky Mountain Health Maintenance Organization, Inc. submitted to the Attorney General its plan to convert from a nonprofit status to for-profit, and its subsequent sale to United HealthCare Services, Inc. The Attorney General is reviewing the proposed conversion under her common law authority over charitable trusts. The terms of the proposed conversion and sale, as submitted to the Attorney General, can be found on the Attorney General's website.
